



# MLA Institutes on Reading and Writing Pedagogy at Access-Oriented Institutions

This summer institute is a sponsored opportunity to engage with theory and practice of teaching reading and writing at access-oriented institutions. Join a regional cohort of fellow graduate students and early career faculty members for a week of critical pedagogical inquiry and a series of panels with experienced community college faculty members and students.

The institute includes

- in-person and remote attendance options
- lunches and two dinners for all in-person attendees
- free housing options for in-person attendees

Participants will develop a pedagogical project and gain access to a wide range of classroom-ready materials for teaching reading and writing. This institute will also connect participants with a career-sustaining professional community of teacher-scholar activists.

Participants have the option to pursue several additional opportunities after the institute:

- Complete a project by August 2023 to earn three tuition-free Writing and Rhetoric Studies graduate credits from the University of Utah.
- Present at the Two-Year College English Association (TYCA-West) conference.
- Develop a publication for the journal *Teaching English in the Two-Year College*.

In-person participants are responsible for transportation costs.
